THE TOURNAMENT

Eagle Eye provides a challenge from any of five sets of tees. Its signature Island Green at 17 is not to be missed. Chris Lutzke, in collaboration with Pete Dye, designed a rolling links style course featuring magnificent shot values on every hole.

Eagle Eye was rated the fifth best public championship golf course in the nation in 2017 by Golf Advisor raters and in 2014 *Golf Digest* magazine called it Michigan's fifth-best public course. It was named *Michigan's Golf* magazine's fourth-best championship course in 2014.

The tournament will be a scramble format, which requires that the tee shot of each player in a foursome be used a minimum of three times. Players may also choose to purchase three feet of string and/or mulligans to help with their team score. Skins will also be played this year.

Prizes will be awarded in four divisions (men's, women's, mixed doubles and open). Prizes will also be awarded for a number of skill shots. A silent auction will follow the tournament.

Each entry fee includes a \$100 tax deductible/tax credit donation to Michigan State University. Staff, student, spouse and sponsored student fees are reduced and will not include a tax credit. The balance of the fee covers green fees, cart, lunch and reception at the course.
